As is our custom during Thanksgiving trips, there will be a traditional Thanksgiving dinner on the evening of Thursday November 28. Pricing

Priced at \$3,480 per person including roundtrip airfare to/from Los Angeles to Fiji (Nadi International Airport). Based on double occupancy (add \$500 for single supplement). Non-diver priced at \$2,980. A non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is required to secure your space with final payment due by end of July.

Flight Information

Departure from Los Angeles on November 21

We depart from Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) at 10:45pm via Fiji Airways on Flight FJ811. We recommend arriving in Los Angeles no later than 6:45pm in order to have plenty of time to collect your baggage from the domestic terminal and make your way to the international terminal to check in for your Fiji Air flight. Going in a day before departure is also an option for ensuring you do not miss the flight out.

We will be crossing the international dateline during our 11 hour flight and will arrive at Nadi International Airport (NAN) at 5:45 am on November 23rd.

Arrival in Los Angeles on November 30

We will depart Fiji Airways flight FJ810 from Nadi International Airport at 9:40pm and will be arriving in Los Angeles at 11:50am on November 30th (since we cross back over the international dateline). We recommend allowing at least 3 hour layover between landing at 11:50am and departing for Denver...this allows time to collect bags and check into your domestic flight while also allowing a bit of buffer in case the Fiji Air flight is delayed.

Baggage Allowances

Fiji Air allows each passenger one 30 kg (66 lbs) checked bag and a single 7 kg (15 lbs) carryon item. In the past, I have used a collapsible duffel bag that will be checked from Denver to LAX and then combine the duffel into a single larger suitcase when checking in for Fiji Airways (and the opposite on the way back).

Itinerary at Bega

Arrival Day - November 23, 2024 arrive in Nadi International airport (NAN) at 5:45am. Ride in Beqa Lagoon Resort's bus for approximately 2.5 hours to Pacific Harbor on the south part of the island. We will stop halfway for a short coffee and bathroom break (great place to stock up on any last minute items or shop for souvenirs). From there, we will take boat(s) across the channel to get to Beqa Island. Note that the landing at the resort is a "wet landing" and you will be in knee deep water as you exit the boat. Welcoming you to the island are the local Fijian staff along with a poolside foot massage after your long flight!

After an orientation briefing with the resort, you will be given your bure assignments so you can unpack. Dive gear should be brought to the dive shop so it can be tagged with your identifier to ensure your gear follows you to your boat each day.

Daily Activities for November 24, 2024 through November 29, 2024

Breakfast of eggs, pancakes/French toast, fruits, cereals, toast, etc. along with juice, milk, coffee and tea will be served each day. During breakfast staff will be taking your lunch and dinner orders for the day. On Thursday November 28th, as is our American tradition, we will enjoy a full Thanksgiving dinner...come hungry!!

After breakfast the group will sit for a dive briefing together before loading onto their individual boats. Included in your package is five days of two tank dives, departing in the morning and returning just

before lunch. One of those days will be set aside for the Cathedral Shark Dive (this is done in smaller groups of up to 20 divers). For additional charge you can do a second day of shark diving.

Each afternoon lunch will be served and typically there is a cultural activity (touring the local school and village, hiking to the waterfall, learning about basket weaving, etc.). Many evenings there are performances of fire dancers, fire walkers and more. When we arrive at Beqa, the schedule of events for our week will be posted along with sign ups for some of the other activities which are offered from local tour guides.

Dress code for visiting the village: Some of the cultural activities will take you into the village...it is customary to have your head uncovered (no hats, sunglasses, etc.) and to have your shoulders and knees covered (a sarong from the gift shop is a great option – they will show you how to wear and tie it).

Departure Day - November 30, 2024

Beqa staff will give details on the process during our dinner the night before departure. Once your bags are packed you can leave them on your porch for pickup. We will be departing Beqa in the morning, crossing over the channel to Pacific Harbor where we will return to Nadi International Airport via shuttle. We will arrive at the airport by mid day however since our flight does not depart until 9:40pm, 3F will be working to secure day rooms to reduce the amount of time we wait at the airport...more information will be forthcoming on the availability and cost of the rooms.
